1. CHAIRPERSON'S WELCOME & PERSONAL MATTERS

Cllr. Angharad Jones welcomed everyone to the meeting. The extraordinary meeting had been convened to establish a way of helping Shaun and Erin Harvey, whose son, Zac Harvey, had tragically, lost his life, during a caravan fire at Ffair Rhos on the 19th January 2020. His brother Harley had been left in a critical condition. Shaun Harvey had also suffered injuries. Members of the Community Council had been deeply saddened by the event.

5. Cllr John Jones had spoken to the Press on behalf of the Community Council. A Just Giving page had been set up where individuals could make a donation. County Cllr Ifan Lloyd Davies raised implications for the Community Council when making a contribution.

Cllr John Jones proposed that £500 be given by the Community Council; this was unanimously agreed. It was stated that £500 would meet travelling costs to the hospital in part, at £0.45 per mile. A record of the mileage would be required.
