**2. The Queen's Platinum Jubilee – National Lottery Awards for All: OV Wales**

National Lottery funding is available to mark Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in 2022. The Queen's Platinum Jubilee National Lottery Awards for All is accepting applications for projects costing less than £10,000 for communities developing projects to join in with the celebrations. Projects should meet the standard aims and eligibility criteria set of the grant programme. Whilst not essential, the strongest projects will also meet three focus areas: promote relationships across generations; develop the skills and experience of communities; encourage the care of/action in the natural world as part of the celebrations. One off events on the day of the Jubilee, which meet these criteria will be accepted. The strongest applications will demonstrate a lasting impact beyond the event itself. It is likely that the Lottery will receive more applications than it is able to fund.

**3. The following activities were considered** for Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2022.

- 1.1 Rewind 70 years and hold competitions, which were popular at that time e.g., 3-legged race; egg and spoon; relays, tug-of-war.
- 1.2 Bouncy Castle
- 1.3 Giant Bubbles – kits
- 1.4 Balloons – helium?
- 1.5 Bunting would be required.
- 1.6 Food: everyone to bring food. An afternoon tea was favoured (2-4pm) and food, which was popular 70years ago was discussed.
- 1.7 An ice-cream van was considered. It was not established whether individuals would pay for ice-cream.
- 1.8 Alcoholic drinks: it was not ascertained whether alcoholic drinks would be permitted.
- 1.9 Commemorative Mugs: to be given to all pupils of Bont School and Ysgol Feithrin. It was agreed to find out the cost by the next meeting (CH) from a Tregaron business.
- 1.10 Prizes: medals; ribbons.

The itinerary of the commemoration would involve, in this order – Sports, afternoon tea, distribution of mugs. Start time 2pm.
