7. MATTERS ARISING

7.1 Pantyfedwen Play Area: A Site Meeting had been held on Tuesday 4 April 2023 under the direction of Stefano Antoniazzi (SA), Ceredigion County Council, Cllr Gareth Owen and Mrs Clare Hughes. New mats were required. Match funding will be necessary when applying for a grant. Grants could be available to meet the match-funding e.g., for a grant of £10,000, £10,000 could be met by another grant. SA to seek further information.

Cllr Gareth Owen had contacted 5 Play Area Surface providers.

1. RTC Safety Surfaces Ltd

Option 1: RTC to remove old tiles and exchange for black wet pour: Estimate: £11,919.00 ex VAT

Option 2: Black Wet Pour: Existing tiles to be removed and disposed of by others: Estimate: £8,217 excluding VAT.

2. DCM Surfaces: Wet Pour: £8,819 ex VAT.

3. Playtop

Wet Pour Rubber Surfacing (recycled product): £13,979 ex VAT.

4. Abacus Playgrounds Ltd

To supply and install wetpour £16,775 (ex VAT)

ROSPA Play Inspection 2023: had taken place in June £75 + VAT. The Report had been circulated to members, who will assign attention to the matters arising, during the forthcoming months.

7.2 Teifi Pools: signs to deter certain vehicles from using this area: It was questioned whether installing signs by the Community Council, was permitted.

7.3 Defibrillators within the vicinity
The total number of defibrillators within Ffair Rhos and Bont Fair was now 4 viz:
1. The Teifi Inn: Ffair Rhos (the Community Council had provided the box)
2. Pantyfedwen Hall, Bont: Clare Hughes authorised Guardian within the Circuit.
3. Village Shop, Bont: Ceredig: authorised Guardian within the Circuit.
4. Strata Florida Abbey. (the Community Council provided the box): Cllr Ifan Lloyd Davies to liaise with the Committee. It will be necessary to assign an authorised Guardian for this defibrillator.
The Headteacher of Bont School had agreed for a further defibrillator to be positioned on the school premises). Arrangements ongoing. A location is sought for this defibrillator. (possibly within the carpark)

7.4 Floods in the environs of the River Teifi: Attention to be assigned to the trimming of certain trees in the vicinity. Cllr Richard Jones will attend to the matter.

7.6 Flags: Ffair Rhos and surrounding area: It was AGREED for Cllr Ieuan Davies to purchase 6 Flags x £50. Ongoing.

7.7 Main bridge of the Village: Construction work ongoing.

7.8 Model Standing Orders – Revised (as received from One Voice Wales). Attention was assigned to this document and relevant information added. The Clerk to update the document and forward to members before uploading onto the Community Council's website.

7.9 Remembrance Sunday Service: Sunday 12th November 2023 @ 10.40am at Bont War Memorial. Cllr Ifan Lloyd Davies will liaise with former Community Cllr John Jones and Rev. Aled Lewis re the Order of Service and inform individuals of their tasks. Cllr Gareth Owen had ordered the Wreath from the British Legion, Tregaron.
